Gum Tragacanth E-413 Application



- 1. Gum tragacanth is a natural thickner agent used traditionally mainly in icecream, marcipan and choclate production (>500 t/year) in the Middle East, Europe (Germany) and US.
- 2. Gum tragacanth is also used to make a paste used in floral sugarcrafts to create lifelike flowers on wires used as decorations for cakes
- 3. Gum tragacanth is also used in production of natural hair shampoo and gel and other natural cosmetica.













Gum Tragacanth E-413 produced in Isfahan on behalf of Daryabsofe

Tragacanth is a natural gum obtained from the dried sap of several species of Astroagalus plant grows best in the semi-arid region of the oasis of Isfahan/Iran—with the Zāyandarud as a main water resource—marked by a moderate climate and four distinct seasons, including the subprovinces of Tirān and Karvan, Najafābād, Lenjān, Mobāraka, Falāvarjān, Komeynišahr (formerly Mārbin), and Isfahan.

Daryabsofe's specialists ensure the highest quality of the harvested gum Tragacanth by selecting, cleaning and testing of each charge of the harvest buyed by producer directley from the collectors.

Only those charges which fulfill defined quality standards (e.g. Tragacanthin > 20% and Bassorin >70%) are selected.

By careful mixing of different charges the producer keeps the overall quality of Tragacanth constant.

The Storage and packaging of prepared for export is performed by producer on behalf of Daryabsofe.
